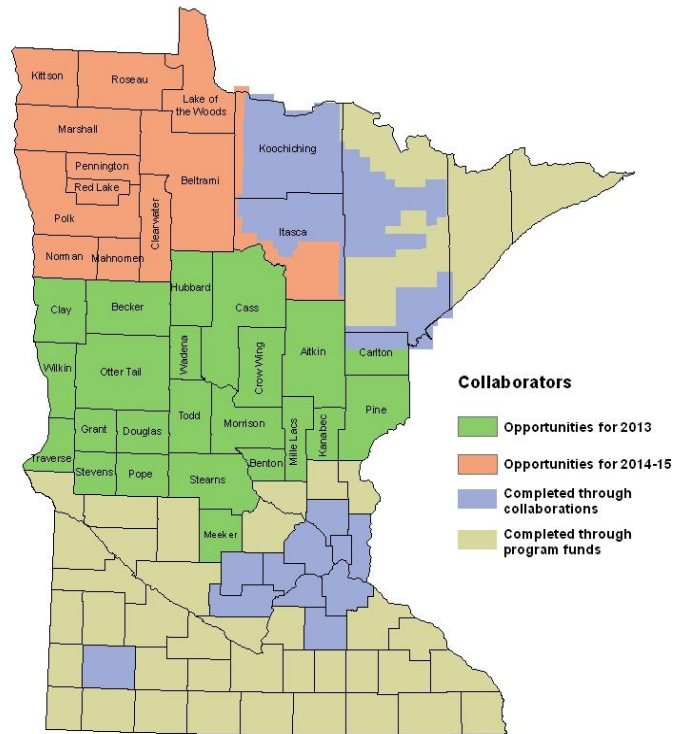


Spring Aerial Imagery Opportunities

The State of Minnesota is implementing a phased update of the National Wetland Inventory that will require up-to-date, spring leaf-off, natural color and infrared aerial photography. The program is called SAIP (Spring Aerial Imagery Program) and the next area scheduled for flights in 2013 is a 22-county region in central Minnesota. The Northwest counties of Minnesota are targeted for collection in 2014 or 2015. An information meeting on both these projects will be held in Bemidji on April 3, 2012.

Chris Cialek (MnGeo), Steve Kloiber (DNR) and Pete Jenkins (MnDOT) will provide background information about these projects and would like to discuss possible collaborations with counties interested in leveraging state funds to acquire higher-resolution imagery. You're invited to attend.
