Agenda Topics

The primary topic of the meeting is to decide whether the DCDC should continue to exist, and if so, if it should exist as a committee or as a workgroup. To help reach that decision we need to:

1. Identify topics, projects, or issues we want to work on. These might include:
 - a. Create a geo-spatial standard for parcel data and/or publish and promote a parcel fabric template
 - b. Oversee the coordination of address point data, Enhanced-911 data, and parcel data
 - c. Coordinate the integration of county parcel data with MnDOT ROW data
 - d. Champion and oversee improvements to the statewide PLS40 data
2. Complete MnGeo's "[Committee and Workgroup Charter Template](#)"

After we accomplish these tasks it should become obvious if the DCDC will continue past the completion of the Parcel Data Exchange Attribute Standard and the implementation of the Parcel Business Plan.
