Current Language

(g) Electronic geospatial government data maintained by a government entity shall be shared at no cost to government entities and federal and tribal government agencies. Request for copies of the data under this section must be made to the government entity that originally developed the data. Any data received by a government entity under this subdivision may only be reproduced or redistributed as permitted by the government entity that developed the data. Government entities are immune from civil liability for any data shared at no cost as provided by this subdivision.

Draft IPAD Amendment

Allow option for some costs to share the data to be paid, add sharing for Gopher One and add a definition of geospatial/GIS data.

(g) Electronic geospatial government data maintained by a government entity shall be shared, at no more than the actual costs of sharing the data, to government entities, the notification center established under section 216D.03, and federal and tribal government agencies. Request for copies of the data under this section must be made to the government entity that originally developed the data. "Electronic geospatial" means "digital data using geographic or projected map coordinate values, identification codes and associated descriptive data to locate and describe boundaries or features on, above or below the surface of the earth or characteristics of the earth's inhabitants or its natural or human-constructed features". Any data received by a government entity under this subdivision can be inspected at no cost and may only be reproduced or redistributed as permitted by the government entity that developed the data. Government entities are immune from civil liability for any data shared as provided by this subdivision.

Alternate Amendment

Revise draft language to include data developed to maintained, add institutions of higher education to eligible entities, and permit redistribution of data to qualified entities while protecting source organization's right to control distribution to other parties.

(g) Electronic geospatial government data developed or maintained by a government entity shall be made available to other government entities, including local, state, federal and tribal government agencies, to the notification center established under section 216D.03, and to accredited institutions of higher education for no more than the actual cost of providing the data. "Electronic geospatial" means digital data using geographic or projected map coordinate values, identification codes and associated descriptive data to locate and describe boundaries or features on, above or below the surface of the earth or characteristics of the earth's inhabitants or its natural or human-constructed features. Any data received by a government entity under this subdivision can be inspected at no cost and may only be reproduced or redistributed to organizations not specified in this subdivision as permitted by the government entity that developed the data. Government entities are immune from civil liability for any data shared as provided by this subdivision.
